This year, 5th graders will be playing both recorders and ukuleles. Before the students can play the instruments in class, they must read and get this form signed and returned to Ms. Joo Sin. Please read the following information carefully. Once this permission slip is returned, each student will get their assigned recorder and ukulele.

Recorders

Each student will be assigned a recorder to use in class. They must only use the instrument assigned for these instruments do not get cleaned until the end of the school year. If a student damages the recorder beyond regular wear and tear, the student and parents are responsible for making a payment of \$7, which will cover the cost of the recorder and shipping. If a student wishes to use their own recorder, they must have it for every music class.

Ukuleles

Starting in October, 5th graders will use ukuleles to accompany themselves while singing. Students will share ukuleles in small groups. If there is a damage beyond regular wear and tear while a group of students are using the ukulele, they will be responsible for paying for the cost of repair. If you would like more information on what qualifies as a damage beyond regular wear and tear, please ask.

Students are allowed to bring their own ukuleles for music class, as long as they take full responsibility of the instruments. They may bring it to music class in the morning and pick it up at the end of the day.

Parents and guardians may say their child will not play the ukulele since ukulele is not part of regular music curriculum. Those students will work on supplemental activities. However, recorders ARE part of CCSD's music curriculum and every student must play either the school's recorder or their own.
